



First United Methodist Church Broken Arrow COVID-19 Policies and Procedures:

UPDATED AS OF 5.16.21

- As of May 16th, 2021 if you are fully vaccinated, you may choose to discontinue wearing a mask at church, including during worship. If you are not fully vaccinated, we ask that you continue to wear a mask.
- As of April 4, 2021 we will no longer block off every other pew. We will ask everyone to maintain a three foot (3 ft.) distance between their household and other households.

STANDARD COVID-19 POLICIES

- If you are aware that you have been exposed to a person with COVID-19 and have been in close contact, and you are not showing any symptoms you may return to church activities after day 10 without a test.
- If you are aware that you have been exposed to a person with COVID-19 and have been in close contact, and you are not showing any symptoms, after day 7 and after receiving a negative test result (test must occur on day 5 or later) you may return to church activities.
(Close contact is within 6ft of a positive case of COVID-19)
- If someone in your house has COVID-19 please quarantine from the church for 10 days, or sooner with negative results from a COVID-19 test.
- Monitor your health – If you have a fever/symptoms, please stay home and watch the online services.
- If you have been sent home to quarantine/isolate from school/work due to exposure to someone with COVID-19 please stay home from church for 10 days, or until you receive negative results from a COVID-19 test.
- If you are fully vaccinated, you may choose to discontinue wearing a mask at church, including during worship. If you are not fully vaccinated, we ask that you continue to wear a mask.
- Wash/Sanitize Hands Frequently.
